



Residential Transportation Policy and Procedures

- I. Anyone transporting an ABLE client on behalf of the agency shall have a valid current driver's license.
- II. Any driver transporting ABLE clients on behalf of the agency shall not have any DUI and/or reckless or careless driving convictions in the past seven years.
- III. Any vehicle used for agency business must carry liability insurance at a recommended minimum of \$300,000.00 per incident, with a preference for a higher rate of coverage. Insurance must be kept in effect at all times.
- IV. The insurance carrier, for any vehicle used regularly for agency business, should be notified as to the business use of the vehicle for work.
- V. ABLE does not protect non-employees from liability for injuries incurred while loading, transporting or unloading clients from any vehicle not owned by the company.
- VI. ABLE clients are to be afforded any/all safety measures depicted in ABLE policies, trainings and State and Federal laws at all times during transport.
